Watershed protection and conservation planning

We have prepared Clean Water Management Trust Fund (CWMTF) grant applications for the Town of Troy, Town of Jonesville, Handy Sanitary District (Davidson County), and Town of Walnut Cove, and coordinated these applications with other cost-sharing sources, including Parks and Recreation Trust Fund, Natural Heritage Trust Fund, NCDWQ Construction Grants & Loans, and local land trusts.

RJG&A staff also worked with NC State University (NCSU) and Chatham County staff to successfully obtain EPA 319 and CWMTF grants for watershed protection plans in the Upper Cape Fear River basin; and with the Triangle Land Conservancy, Piedmont Conservation Council, and Chatham Conservation Partnership to obtain grants through Z. Smith Reynolds, NC Urban and Community Forestry, and Wildlife Action Opportunities Fund for the first county-wide comprehensive conservation plan in North Carolina.
