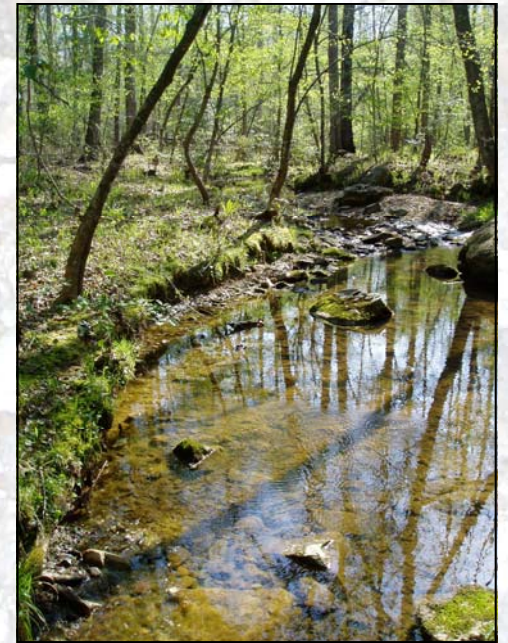

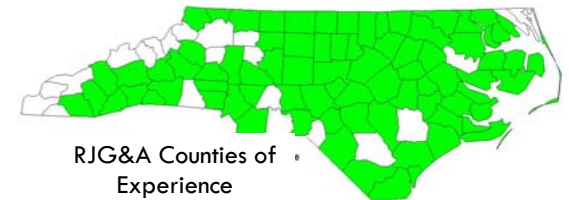
The North Carolina coast after Hurricane Floyd.
